

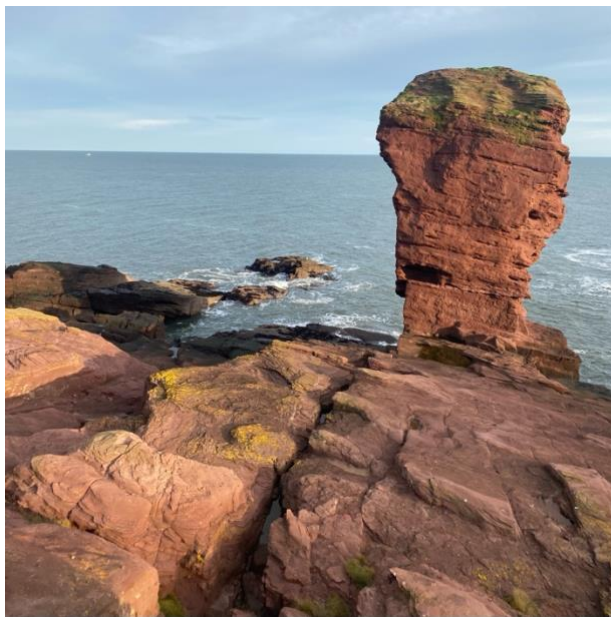

What's Included?

A guided walk led by a local geologist along the Arbroath Cliff Trail travelling the paved path and occasionally stepping on to headlands to admire the view. The guide will explain the story as your clients walk, stopping at key points to illustrate the story. The walk starts at Whiting Ness King's Drive car park and ends at Carlingheugh Bay before turning around and coming back.

- Duration: 2.5 hours
- Maximum 10 guests
- We recommend from 12 years of age, dogs are welcome on lead
- Clients must be able to walk for 2.5 hrs on a flat surface apart from an initial ramp up to cliff top
- Toilets and parking for cars and small buses available at start of walk all year round
